Freedom of Information Request

Thank you for your request for information received by the Council. In your request you asked for the following information:

The total amount of PCN's issued and the value in UK pounds in Penalty charges that has been earned from the date of April 2018 - April 2019 of the camera, restricting vehicle entrance between the hours of 10am to 10pm in Orford Road, Walthamstow Village, E17.

In response, I can confirm that the London Borough of Waltham Forest (LBWF) does hold the requested information and can advise you as follows:

For the period of April 2018 – April 2019 for the location and camera in question, the total amount of PCN's issued was 9,685 PCNs and the total amount of monies received was £547,369.29.
